He became a member of the Royal College of Physicians in 1996. He then undertook a significant period of Neuroscience research (University College London 1997, Imperial College 1998-2002), culminating in a PhD (University of London, 2004), then 5 years of Specialist Neurology Training (King's College Hospital, Atkinson Morley's Hospital, The National Hospital, Hammersmith Hospital, Charing Cross Hospital) 2002-2007. He was appointed Consultant Neurologist at Chase Farm Hospital and the Royal Free Hospital in February 2007.
