Training and Background

Mr Law was appointed as consultant general and vascular surgeon in 1994. He qualified at St Bartholomews Medical School and completed his thesis on wound healing with prosthetic materials at the Westminster Hospital. His training in vascular surgery included time at the Royal Bournemouth and Charing Cross hospitals and his training in thyroid surgery was undertaken at the Chelsea and Westminster and Royal Marsden hospitals.

He introduced Carotid artery surgery to the Trust and established a community based venous ulcer service in Enfield and Cheshunt. He undertakes a wide range of venous, peripheral arterial and aneurysm surgery including aneurysm stents. He has recently started a combined thyroid clinic with the endocrinologists.
